DEADLINE: The mares must be officially nominated before Dec 31 of the breeding year for the foal to become eligible for the AHBA Legacy Futurity Classes. Metered mail is not acceptable after December 31, 2023 without a U.S./Canadian Post Office cancellation mark. Nominated foals for the AHBA Futurity Legacy Program will compete only as ATH Yearlings in the AHBA World Cup show and now will have a two year old class combined with the Auction Two Year Old Foals. The Prize money for these Legacy classes will be provided from the Mare Nominationfees collected prior to the birth of the eligible foals.
